# New Police Academy Partnership

Anna Maria College has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Massachusetts Municipal Police Training

Committee (MPTC) to streamline the process for qualified Anna Maria seniors to enter an MPTC academy. MPTC is the state agency charged with providing training for police officers. This partnership is a significant step forward for aspiring law enforcement officers in Massachusetts, providing a clear educational path to a meaningful career and Anna Maria will be the first four-year institution to partner with MPTC. "The MPTC is committed to investing in the future generation of law enforcement officers who will serve and protect the great communities across the state," said MPTC Executive Director Robert Ferullo (Ret. Police Chief). "This partnership with Anna Maria College is a continued effort to support opportunities for individuals to embark on the journey to a meaningful career in law enforcement through different avenues like undergraduate and graduate criminal justice programs."

Students enjoyed a full week of fun during Spring Week, which was held April 15-21.



- Spring Fusion Festival




The week was capped off by our **Spring Carnival**with music, games,
