### **RESIDENCE LIFE NOTES**

**Thanksgiving Break:** Residence Halls will close on Tuesday, November 26, 2024 at 5 p.m. and will re-open on Sunday, December 1, 2024 at 10 a.m. Students can request to stay late or stay on-campus over the break for extenuating circumstances by completing the Break Housing Form, which was emailed out to all students. We ask that students please submit the form by Monday, November 18. During the Thanksgiving Break, there are no dining services on campus, but all residence halls have common area kitchens that all students can utilize. We also encourage students to fill out the Food Pantry Form if they need additional food during this time. All questions can be directed to reslife@annamaria.edu.

Winter Break: Residence Halls will close on Friday, December 13, 2024 at 5 p.m. and will re-open on Wednesday, January 13, 2024. Training Future Paramedics:
New Track and Space Expands Student Opportunities

In the wake of the pandemic, many industries are experiencing worker shortages and sadly the EMS field is no exception. To address the evolving landscape of first responder professions, Anna Maria College recently created a **dual track program** for Paramedics and Fire Science that gives students the competitive edge and comprehensive training that they need to succeed as emergency departments increasingly seek professionals with these combined skills.

In addition to the new academic track, Anna Maria introduced its **new Nursing** and Paramedic space in Miriam Hall. The 7,000 square foot renovated healthcare space includes a dedicated training area for students pursuing Paramedic Science degrees and EMT certifications.



# New Grants Enable Program Expansion, Equipment and Trainings

Anna Maria was awarded \$1 Million DOJ Grant to Launch a School Safety and Mental Health Initiative.

This federal grant from the Department of Justice will help us implement the Supportive School Safety Intervention Project (SIP) in Anna Maria received \$30,000 from Reliant Foundation to Support Mental Health Workforce Development.

The grant helps expand our Job Opportunities in Behavioral Services (JOBS) II Project, a program that builds a diverse Central Massachusetts to help increase school safety by addressing mental health challenges and promoting supportive learning environments. The grant will support the work of Anna Maria's Mental Health Institute through training funds. Over three years, Anna Maria aims to train 1,500 individuals in mental health first aid, reaching schools in four districts initially and expanding outreach across Central Massachusetts.

pipeline of qualified professionals in mental and behavioral health fields. This funding will directly support initiatives to train and equip students for careers in high-demand areas of mental health, addiction counseling, and social work. Reliant's grant will provide financial support for internship stipends, harm reduction training, and educational resources, including Narcan training for students and staff.

Anna Maria College is the recipient of grants from three Worcester-based foundations: The George I. Alden Trust, The Fletcher Foundation, and the Stoddard Charitable Trust.

Totaling \$975,000, these funds will be used to support Anna Maria College's new **Nursing Simulation and Clinical Labs**. These local foundations have been generous long-time supporters. Similar to these recent donations toward our healthcare space, these partners were instrumental backers during the 2019 renovation of the campus center.
