Servant of God Thea Bowman

Bertha Bowman was born in Mississippi in 1937. Although her father was a doctor and her mother a teacher, her grandfather had been a slave before the emancipation. Her family were devout Methodists, and at age 9, Bertha converted to Catholicism. When she was just fifteen years old, she answered the call from the Lord and entered religious life. Sister Thea Bowman was passionate about evangelizing Black Catholics in the United States. Wounded by the horrific history of slavery, abuse, and segregation, many Black Americans didn't see a place for them in the Church. Sister made it her mission to highlight their contribution and belonging. The joy of Christ in her heart radiated throughout the United States and Central America, and her work bore fruits of peace and unity.

Her feast day is March 30.
